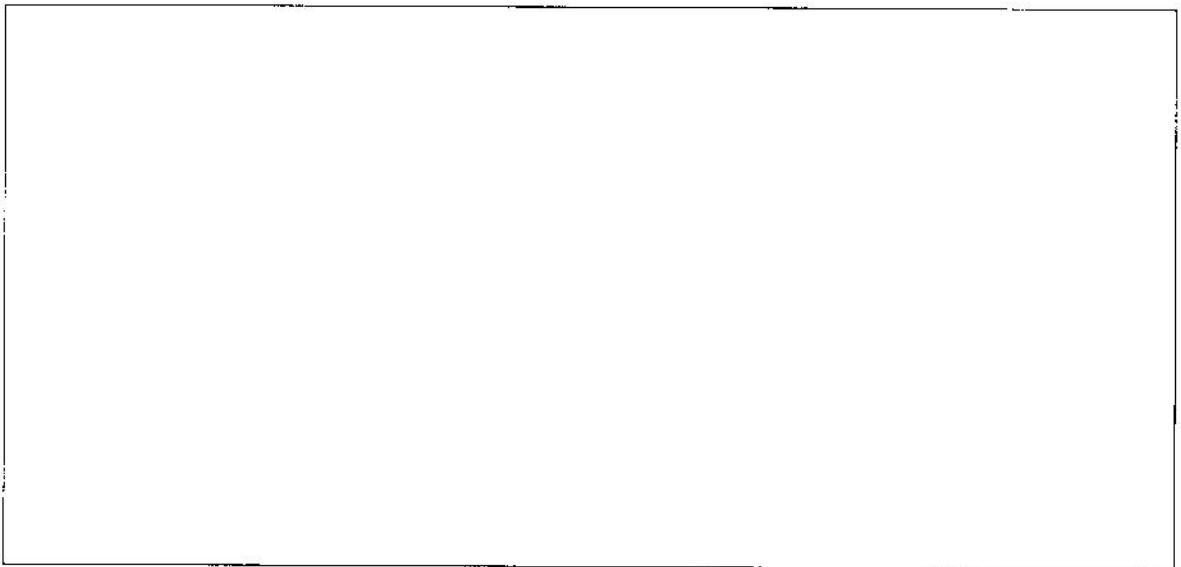

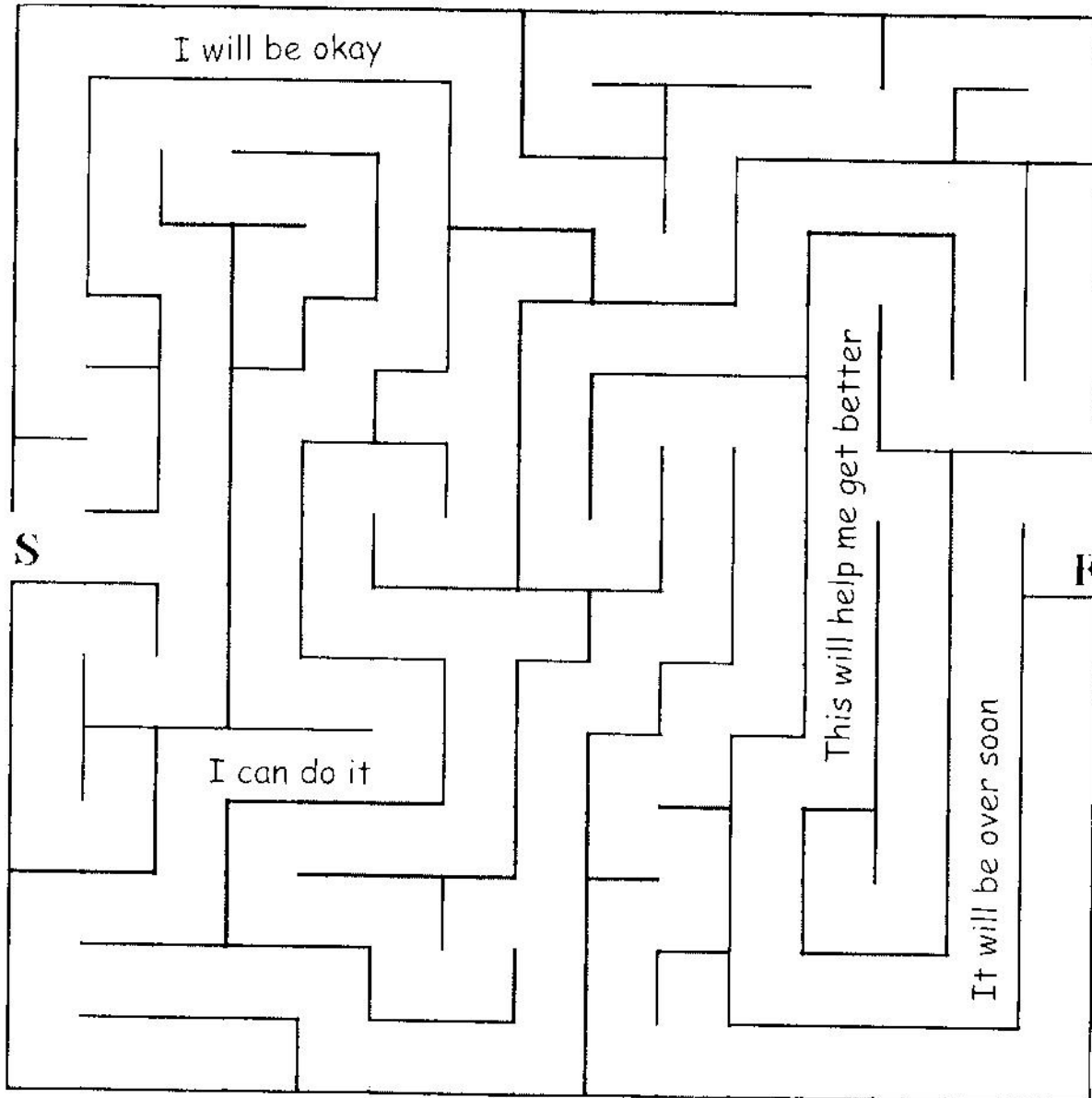


# Think Amazing Thoughts
